


Chocolate Day on 7 th Of July 2 0 2 2. Chocolate symbolizes

- 1. Recognise that anxiety is an emotional response to stress/perceived stress.
- 2. Get adequate sleep: Studying throughout the day and night without proper



sleep can take a toll on your body, resulting in dizziness, dullness and irritability.

- 3. Start your day with a healthy breakfast.
- 4. Give yourself room to focus: Take a minute to sit,

breathe and mentally prepare yourself for the work you are going to do. A bit of planning can help you tackle a lot.

- 5. Take a break: Instead of studying till you're tired, taking small breaks throughout the day, will help you keep a clear and calm head.
- 6. Maintain distance from your phone and social media.
- 7. While studying, be honest with yourself: Set realistic targets when you are preparing for your exams. Plan a realistic revision timetable and map it against your most productive hours for best results




knowledge books also strengthen and shape our mind. Hence, our school ensures that the students and teachers get enough opportunities to read and explore different genres.
